


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What can families do?

PBIS would not be successful without family support. Here are some ways in which families can help their child be successful in school:

- *Talk with your child at home about the common expectations.
- *Celebrate positive behavior that your child displays at home or at school.
- *Become an active participant at school through PTO or attend activities/events.
- *Follow up with your child if there is a consequence for their behavior.
- *Discuss how the common expectations at school are related to the expectations at home.

What is PBIS?

PBIS is a framework for helping Blumfield staff to help students develop and enhance behavioral and social skills that positively impact academics and attendance. By working together, staff, students, and parents help create a safer more effective school environment.

What are common expectations at Blumfield?

All common expectations are clearly defined and are taught and reviewed with all students.

The expectations are posted throughout the school in designated areas.

PBIS AT BLUMFIELD

There are 4 levels students can achieve.

TOKEN SYSTEM/BLUMFIELD STORE LEVEL 1

Students are rewarded with tokens for displaying appropriate behavior and they can be given by any staff member. These tokens can be used to purchase items from the Blumfield Store.

TICKETS LEVEL 2

Tickets are given out to students by any staff member when they portray safe, responsible and respectful behaviors. The tickets are placed in their classroom bucket. At the end of the month an assembly is held and 2 tickets are pulled from each class. Those students receive a book, a certificate and a treat.

BOBCAT BRACELETS LEVEL 3

Bobcat Bracelets are rewarded to 2 students in each class, each week. Students who wear the bracelet have earned special privileges for always being safe, respectful and responsible.



PAWS LEVEL 4

Students can receive PAWsitive Notes throughout the year for being safe, respectful and responsible. Once a student earns 4 PAWsitive Notes, their picture is taken with the Bobcat paw and placed on the bulletin board for everyone to see. At the end of the year, those students are invited to a pizza party to celebrate.
